Last year during summer vacation I visited Ahmedabad . So here I am presenting a brief description about the city.

Ahmedabad also known as amdavad or karnavati is the largest city and former capital of Gujarat which is a state in India. It is the administrative headquarters of the Ahmedabad district and the seat of the Gujarat High

Court. Ahmedabad's population of **5,633,927** makes it the fifth most populous city in India. Ahmedabad is located on the bank of the Sabarmati River, **30km (19mi)** from the state capital Gandhi Nagar.

I. Sabarmati Ashram- It is more famous for Sabarmati Ashram which was founded by Mahatma Gandhi.

2. River Front-Sabarmati Riverfront is a water front being developed along the bank of Sabarmati river in Ahmedabad. People can walk, sit, play and enjoy the scenic beauty of the place.

3. Kankaria Lake -It is the second largest lake in Ahmedabad which is situated in the Southeastern part of the city, in the Maninagar area. A lake front is developed around it, which has many public attraction.

4. Akshardham Temple-Is is a large temple of Swaminarayan who was the former spiritual head of BAPS Swaminarayan Sanstha. At the centre of 23-acre complex is the Akshardham Mandir, which is built from 6,000 metric tons of pink sandstone. There are five exhibition halls use audio-visual presentation and life-sized dioramas.
